Certificate in Children's Care, Learning & Development

Introduction

The CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Children's Care, Learning & Development is a 2 year course which provides a qualification for students who wish to work with children aged 0-16 years in settings or services whose main purpose is children's care, learning and development.

Course Content

- Unit 1 Principles and values underpinning the care, learning and development sector
- Unit 2 Supporting the provision of safe and effective childcare environments
- Unit 3 Supporting children and young persons development
- Unit 4 Supporting children's play and learning

Assessment

Units 1, 3 and 4 are assessed through an assignment which is set by the awarding body CACHE. Unit 2 is assessed via a multiple choice question paper.

Progression

This qualification will enable you to work towards the NVQ Level 2 in Children's Care, Learning & Development. You may also be able to progress to a related Level 3 qualification

Entry Guidance

In order to take part in this course you need to have a keen interest in childcare and dealing with people. You must also have a good record of attendance and a positive behaviour report from your school.

Entry Criteria (minimum)

- Maths L5
- English L5
- Science L5

There are three stages to entry:

- Application Form – to be submitted through your school
- An opportunity to visit the College and see our facilities and talk to staff
- Successful completion of the pre-course session in June 2009.
