VTCT Level 2 Certificate in Hairdressing

Introduction

This qualification is designed for candidates who wish to work in the hairdressing industry or go on to complete an NVQ course in hairdressing. It will provide the knowledge and practical skills necessary to progress into employment or further training.

Content

The delivery of the course promotes, in an interesting way, skills in:

- Professional approach and appearance
- Health and safety in the salon
- Consultation
- Shampoo and condition the hair
- Set and dry the hair
- Blow dry the hair
- Cut women's hair
- Colour and perm the hair

Assessment

Each unit will be assessed against grading criteria set by the awarding body. A variety of assessment methods are available such as performance observation, written work, case studies and projects.

Progression

On successful completion of this qualification, students may progress on to further studies in hairdressing and/or beauty therapy including apprenticeships/employment.

Entry Guidance

In order to take part in this course you must have a genuine interest in hairdressing and meet the entry criteria as listed below. You must also have a good record of attendance and a positive behaviour report from your school. You will be expected to wear salon uniform as detailed by Bedford College.

Entry Criteria (minimum)

KS3 Predicted Results:

- Maths L5
- English L5
- Science L5

There are three stages to entry:

- Application Form – to be submitted through your school
- An opportunity to visit the College and see our facilities and talk to staff
- Successful completion of the pre-course session in June 2009
