HAB Level 2 NVQ in Multi-Skilled Hospitality Services

Introduction

This qualification is designed to provide the knowledge, understanding and skills necessary to prepare learners for employment or further study. It includes core and specialist units selected by Bedford College to ensure an appropriate learning experience in both the kitchen and front of house in our restaurant. All of the units are directly relevant to the changing needs of the Hospitality industry.

Content

The delivery of the course develops skills through the production and service of suitable menu dishes for the Skyline Restaurant:

- Maintaining a safe, hygienic and secure working environment
- Maintaining food safety when storing, preparing and cooking food
- Give customers a positive impression of yourself and your organisation
- Prepare and clear areas for table service
- Serve food at the table
- Prepare, cook and finish basic pasta dishes
- Prepare vegetables for basic dishes
- Prepare and serve dispensed instant hot drinks
- Prepare and cook meat and poultry

Assessment

Each unit will be assessed against criteria set by the awarding body. Assessment methods used are performance observations and online tests. Emphasis will be placed on the practical application of the criteria by providing a realistic environment for learners through the Skyline Restaurant and kitchens.

Progression

On successful completion of this qualification, students may progress into employment or continue to further their studies in Hospitality. This could include courses such as Sugar-craft, Cake Decorating, and progression to Level 3 Hospitality related programmes.

Entry Guidance

In order to take part in this course you must have a keen interest in the Hospitality & Catering industry. You must also have a good record of attendance and a positive behaviour report from your school. You will be expected to wear Personal Protective Equipment as detailed by Bedford College.

Entry Criteria (minimum)
